

Dear Stilton residents,

The Parish Council knows from speaking to children and parents that a playground for the under-12s is desperately needed in Stilton. These "users" have provided their views of what is wanted. Playground providers have also given us ideas of what to put in the playground. **But where should it be sited?**

There are a number of green spaces around the village. Some are too small and some are distant from the village centre, so walking to them is not easy for some small children.

We're now asking for views from all villagers before a final decision is made. There are three locations big enough and centrally located: *Gala Close*, *Apreece Way* and the *Glebe*; these are shown on the map opposite.

Please let us know your views and ideas for these areas - as a playground or as another amenity space (garden, orchard, etc). Send them to the Parish Clerk by email or put a note in the Parish Room post box in Church Street (you can use the form on the back page of this leaflet). Please add your name and the road where you live. The Parish Clerk's contact details are on the page opposite.


